Court Search Records vs. CBI Arrest Records

Secure Search's records, supplied by our court gateway, and CBI arrest records may appear similar but there are major differences in their content and potential use:

- **Our search engine is updated directly by the courts in real time.** When records are modified by a court clerk, the changes are reflected on the database that Secure Search is linked to at almost the same moment. CBI promises that arrests made will be available in their system within 48 hours.
- Secure Search will collect all records associated with an applicant and print it in our application summary on-line and it will always be retrievable at www.securesearchpro.com.
- **What court records does Secure Search provide?**
Secure Search searches both open and closed cases. In the district courts, cases included in the database include criminal - felonies. In the county courts, the cases in the database include traffic, traffic infraction, civil (to \$10,000), small claims, and misdemeanors. Sealed cases are not available on the site. Also not included are these case types – probate, mental health and juvenile. Additionally, certain information within each case is non-public. Social security numbers are omitted, as are street addresses. All parties to a case except the plaintiff and defendant (and in domestic relations cases, the petitioner and the respondent) are considered non-public. This includes judges, victims, police officers and jurors. Attorney names, however, are public. Long narratives are excluded from the search, as are suppressed, sealed, or confidential filings. Financial information - such as fines - are summarized, not detailed.
- The **CBI database contains information on people arrested AND fingerprinted. *It is estimated that only 60% of the people arrested actually end up in this database.***
- **The CBI database provides arrestee information**, not necessarily what they were finally charged with or whether there was a conviction. Secure Search's search will have dispositions if issued.
- **Although arrest information can be very useful under certain circumstances**, a person is not a criminal until convicted of a crime. Anyone using the presence of an arrest record in the CBI database as a basis for denying employment without checking the actual disposition of the case may be in violation of the Federal Fair Credit Reporting Act as well as state statutes. Even information discovered in the Secure Search process must be checked against actual court records before it can be used for denial of employment.
